



NOTICE OF RACE

WALA SUMMER METRO SERIES 2009/2010

1. The series will be sailed in conjunction with the following events:
 - 1.1. FSC Indian Ocean Classic (31st Oct -1st Nov 2009)
 - 1.2. RPYC Mini Series (21-22 November 2009)
 - 1.3. RFBYC International Classes Regatta – Keane’s Point Championship (12-13 December 2009)
 - 1.4. HYC Pot of Gold Regatta (30th January 2010)
 - 1.5. MYC Annual Regatta (6th March 2010)
 - 1.6. MOFSC Easter Regatta (2-5 April 2010)

(The official starting times for each race will be publicized on the WALA website www.laserwa.asn.au once the official NOR for the respective event is available)
2. If 5 or more races are completed each competitor can exclude their worst score. If 6 races are completed each competitor can exclude their two worst scores.
3. Where the Metro Series event is a multiple number races, the overall placing of each competitor at each event will be their score for the WALA Metro series event
4. Changing sail number is allowed during the series, however due notice must be given to the President of WALA to ensure appropriate scoring.
5. Changing of rig size is allowed during the series; however your regatta score will only count towards the respective rig size division.
6. The Sailing Instructions governing the Racing for the series will be those provided by the host Club at each venue.
7. Prizes will be allocated and divisions determined at the discretion of the WALA Committee.
8. All competitors must be current financial members of the WA Laser Association prior to the competitor’s first metro event. Non-members will not be awarded a result. No exceptions.
9. WALA will not charge any entry fee to participate in the Metro Summer Series but competitors will need to pay the nominated entry fee charged by the Host Club for each series and comply with their Notice of Race.
10. Presentation will be held at the 2010 State Championships – time and date to be confirmed in due course.
